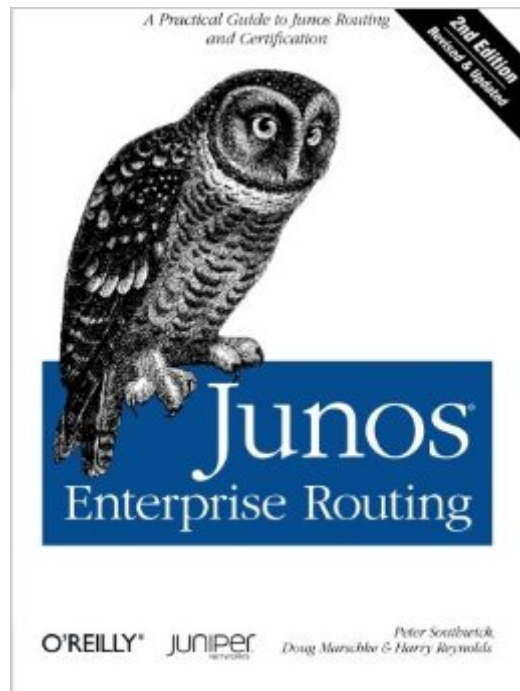

This book has a lot of good information. If you are new to networking it might be a little hard for you to understand and perhaps a more basic text is needed before diving into this one. The authors even note this in the preface I believe. They are assuming that most readers are coming from a Cisco background and therefore have good fundamental knowledge already. Information is technically correct but I would say needs a supplement in some cases if there is a protocol you don't

understand.

If you are deploying or managing JUNOS routers in a enterprise network, this is THE book to have. It does not cover service provider topics such as MPLS, ISIS, or advanced BGP. There are plenty of other books that do. Harry and Doug do an excellent job of filling in the gap that was missing. This book explains how complex topics such as IPSec VPNs, NAT/PAT, Stateful Firewall, BGP policy, IGP migration, etc. all work in JUNOS.

This is a great book it has very language and the explains complex topics very clearly without missing any details. I specifically began reading this book because I could not find any books that explained multicast concepts in a manner that I could understand. I have only read the multicast section but I am sure that the complete book is treasure of good information.

Not all Juniper books are created equal and this one certainly tops my list. This guy should win a award for his wit and apparent knowledge exhibited in each chapter. This book helped me TREMENDOUSLY. Well written and easy to understand...AND kept my attention. They put quizzes at the end of each chapter to make sure you 'got it'. This book is a definite must if you use Juniper. I'd pay money to hear this guy teach a class on this!
